- I. Policy

It is the policy of this Division to provide guidelines, in the form of dress codes, to ensure that officers present a professional appearance when representing the Division and *their duties do not require wearing a uniform. This Directive applies to all officers assigned to work in a plainclothes capacity.*

- II. Procedures

- A. Officer working in plainclothes capacity must have a serviceable uniform and equipment, available at all times while on duty, in the event deployment to patrol becomes necessary.
- B. Plainclothes officers shall be attired in one of the dress options listed below, as appropriate.
- C. Officers attending any court, work-related hearings or public meetings, and not attired in uniform, shall be attired in one of the dress options listed below, as appropriate.
- D. Officers working an undercover, plainclothes, or surveillance detail are exempted from the dress code except when appearing in court.
- E. *Section/Branch Commanders will determine dress codes options (uniform or plainclothes).*

- III. Dress Code Options

- A. Dress suit, or;
- B. Sports Coat/Blazer with dress slacks, dress shirt, and
  1. Ties for males
  2. Skirts or dresses are additional options for females
- C. Suitable dress shoes with socks or stockings
