










2009-2017 FACILITY PLAN AND DESIGN HISTORY

Revised Budget

- Original Budget \$6.99M
- New Budget Park Refresher: \$3M Budget

Technical Documentation and Research:

- Extensive technical documentation including survey, tree root investigation, soil borings, drainage maps
- Grading studies/cut fill studies
- Critical root zone studies
- Tree preservation techniques/details

Woodside Park as URBAN RECREATIONAL PARK

A New Park Classification System

Urban Recreational Park:

Oriented to the recreational needs of a densely populated neighborhood and business district. They provide space for many activities.

May include athletic fields, playing courts, picnicking, dog parks, sitting areas and flexible grassy open space.

Main Program

- Recreational program focused on active recreation
- Supported by contemplative setting and social gathering spaces
- Activities to accommodate all age groups

Key Features

- Playing courts and fields
- Mix of hardscape and grassy open spaces
- Mix of reserved and unreserved recreation spaces
- Central lawn as focal point
- Multi-functional structures and park furniture

EPS – Energized Public Spaces Functional Master Plan

• Gateway Park:

Woodside is important gateway park for both Silver Spring CBD and Montgomery Hills Sector Plans

• Increasing Demand:

New mixed-use developments will increase demand for open space and park amenities. Population majority adult.

• Multi-faceted Urban Park:

Serves Silver Spring CBD and adjacent residential neighborhoods

• Successful Park Needs Strategic Improvements:

Improvement needed to meet growing demand for active recreation and multigenerational activities

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Expand skate spot
- Repurpose tennis court to multi-use court
- Repurpose handball court
- Add multi-generational play/activity areas
- Improve ADA accessibility
- Add walking loop
- Add unprogrammed open space
- Incorporate art in the park
- Improve lighting
- Remove fountain

DESIGN PRIORITIES AND PARK PROGRAM

MEET CURRENT BUDGET (\$2-2.5M Construction Cost)

- work with existing park features
- minimize earthwork
- use materials creatively and efficiently
- prioritize proposed changes and check costs frequently

IMPROVE INFRASTRUCTURE


- remove existing outdated fountain
- include stormwater management
- create accessible routes
- preserve signature tree canopy
- improve access for park maintenance

REIMAGINE CIRCULATION

- highlight entry at Georgia and Spring
- improve visibility/accessibility of park entries
- simplify complicated path network
- reduce steps and pathway grade changes

IMPROVE SAFETY


- provide improved visibility to secluded areas
- improve park lighting




ENHANCE THE FUN STUFF

- expand skate spot
- add multi-generational play/fitness elements
- improve playground areas
- repurpose tennis court for multi sport
- repurpose handball court
- create flexible open space
- incorporate public art





CONCEPT 1 Accessible Routes








