The riding position is seated, recumbent, and low, offering a stable and enjoyable ride for all skill levels.

TerraTrike All Terrain with Power Assist: A foot-pedaled e-assist recumbent bike designed for trail riding in a seated position. It features a wide range of gears and power assist to handle hills, with a wide track for added balance. This bike is suitable for riders who can pedal but require the stability and seating position of a recumbent trike. Grip strength is needed to operate the brakes.
